Application Requirements: The following is a list of the minimum requirements for application to the Region 13 Educator Certification Program for the certification area specified above.

Bachelors Degree earned from and conferred by an institution of higher education that is recognized by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB).

NOTE: Candidates with a degree from a foreign institution must:

- Have transcripts evaluated by <u>Foreign Credentials Service of America</u>, 512.459.8428, showing degree earned and grade equivalencies
- Take the <u>TOEFL iBT</u> (Test of English as a Foreign Language) scoring a minimum of 24-Speaking; 22-Listening; 22-Reading and 21-Writing

If you have a degree from a country where English is the official language, a TOEFL score is <u>NOT</u> required. See <u>approved list.</u>

Note: When registering for the TOEFL, please choose the Region 13 Institution Code - B271

- Minimum 2.50 grade point average (determined in one of the following ways)
 - 2.5 on all coursework (includes all courses from all institutions)
 -OR-
 - 2.75 in last 60 semester hours of completed coursework
 - Please Note: Due to recent changes in the Texas Administrative Code, <u>any</u> applicant who does not meet
 the 2.5 GPA requirement (either overall or in the last 60 hours) <u>must</u> provide a passing score on a TExES
 Pre-Admission Content Test (PACT) in the area of teaching certification to be considered for admission.
 See below for specific PACT information.
- Content Area Proficiency (determined in one of the following ways)
 - 24 semester hours (with coursework minimum GPA of 2.5) in combination of the following:
 - o English (minimum 6 hours)
 - o Mathematics (minimum 3 hours)
 - o Natural Science (minimum 3 hours)
 - Social Studies (minimum 3 hours) (includes: History, Economics, Government)
 - o Remaining 9 hours comprised of any above listed subject
 - NOTE: Statistics will not be counted as principle mathematics course, but will fulfill remaining
 9 hour requirement

Applicant has passed a TExES Pre-Admission Content Test (PACT) in the area of teaching certification. For test information, visit http://www.texes.ets.org/epp/epppact and register for one of the following PACT Tests: Test Code 291 Core Subjects EC-6 for Elementary level positions, or Test Code 211 Core Subjects 4-8 for Middle school level positions, or Test Code 231 ELA grades 7-12, or Test code 235 Math 7-12 for High school level positions
